City of Ojai releases Ojai Day survey, requesting community response to help plan 2023 event

OJAI, CA (February 17, 2023) – Large or moderate, regional or local: The City of Ojai has released a seven-question survey that will help the City consider the format of this year's Ojai Day. Residents may submit the survey [online](#), via phone (805-646-5581 ext. 120) or in-person at City Hall.

"Since this is our signature community event, it's important that we provide the best experience for Ojai Valley residents, and the survey feedback will give us direction on how we can achieve that goal," said Ojai City Manager James Vega.

Over the years, Ojai Day expanded into a regional event with more than 230 vendors from across Southern California and Ojai Avenue was fully to traffic. Post-pandemic, the City hosted a more locally focused Ojai Day at Libbey Park and Bowl that drew an estimated 8,000 people, adding back Ojai Night events in 2022. As the City begins 2023 planning, it will consider community preference, cost, and local impacts in making recommendations for this year's size and scope.
