City Seeks More Public Input on Public Safety and Disaster Preparedness

OJAI, CA (August 26, 2022) The City, along with the Disaster Council, key stakeholders, and a wide range of local and regional partners, is drafting a Community Disaster Guide to help Ojai residents, businesses and visitors, learn about and connect with emergency resources—and be prepared when disaster strikes.

Two key meetings took place in August to gain public and professional input for the Guide. On Wednesday, August 10, 2022, the City hosted a virtual and in-person working meeting where Stakeholders provided input and guidance on our coordinated response to disaster. The meeting included representatives from Police, Fire, Ventura County Office of Emergency Services, healthcare, communications, animal care, and the broader community.
